## CREDIT RECOVERY (\$125) CASH ONLY

**June 5 – July 26 (Monday-Thursday only) 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m.**

Audience: Students who have failed a course required for graduation with a final grade between 45 and 59 with 10 or fewer absences and no substantial discipline issues. If the final average is below a 45 or credits lost due to absences, the course must be completed in Summer School.

\*\*\*Credit Recovery does **NOT** meet the requirements for the NCAA Eligibility Center.

\*\*\*Credit Recovery is not available for 9<sup>th</sup> grade students.

\*\*\* If passed, a final grade of 65/D will be posted to the student's transcripts.

\*\*\*Credit Recovery courses will be reflected on student's transcripts as a Credit Recovery (CR) grade

Description: This program will utilize computer-based instruction. Instruction will target specific remedial content standards in each academic subject area. Certified teachers will be used in core academic areas. Students must attend a minimum of two weeks and must be complete within six weeks to receive credit. Students may recover multiple credits during the term if time allows, but only one course at a time may be attempted. Students must receive approval via Credit Recovery Guidelines set forth by the Autauga County Board of Education.

**June 5 – July 26 (Monday-Thursday only) 7:45 a.m. – 12:45 p.m.**

Audience: Students who have failed a course offered for the summer school term may be taken.  
\*\*\*ACCESS courses **DO** meet the requirement of the NCAA Eligibility Center.  
\*\*\*ACCESS courses are available for all students.  
\*\*\*The ACCESS teacher will assign a final grade based on their mastery of the standards.

Description: This program will operate according to a traditional summer school calendar and daily schedule. Instruction and assignments will be provided through the internet by a highly qualified teacher in the given content area who is working for the state of Alabama. The teacher serving the computer lab will serve as a facilitator between students and the ACCESS teacher. Students must attend all sessions!

# 2017 CREDIT RECOVERY / Summer School Agreement Sheet

## Prattville High School

The Autauga County Board of Education has provided the opportunity for me to attend Summer School/Credit Recovery at Prattville High School. I understand that my enrollment is conditioned upon my willingness to follow summer school rules in addition to normal school policies.

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Because one day of summer school has about the same number of hours as a week of regular school, ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY!!!!

- Students will **not earn credit** and will be dismissed if they miss **more than THREE (3) days**.
- If a student is more than ten (10) minutes late to a class or if he/she checks out with more than ten (10) minutes remaining in the class, he/she will be counted absent for ½ day.
- Two (2) tardies will be counted as an office referral. After two office referrals, the 5<sup>th</sup> tardy will result in dismissal from summer school.
- If a student is withdrawn for attendance reasons, there will be NO REFUND!!!!
- Parents/students are responsible for transportation to and from the summer school/credit recovery site.

Because summer school is an optional opportunity, misbehavior will NOT be tolerated!

- All school rules outlined in the 2016-2017 Student Code of Conduct are in full affect. This includes, but is not limited to, dress code, possession of illegal substances, defiance and disrespectful behavior.
- Upon the second office referral (Class I or II offense), the student will be withdrawn from summer school.
- A student may be withdrawn on the first incident if the behavior is considered a Class III or Class IV offense. Reports will be made to the police as appropriate.
- Students who drive to summer school must follow all rules regarding the use of personal vehicles on campus. The vehicle is subject to search for illegal substances and/or weapons.
- If a student is withdrawn for behavior reasons, there will be NO REFUND!!!

### EXPECTATIONS:

- Be on time and be where you are supposed to be.
- Be prepared and on task in class.
- Respect the rights and responsibilities of others.
- Strive for excellence.

### Other Items to Remember:

- Do not enter a classroom unless a teacher is present.
- If someone asks you to made adjustments to your dress or to surrender contraband materials, you must immediately comply without complaint. These will not necessarily be considered disciplinary issues unless the student is disrespectful or refuses to comply.
- Sleeping in class or refusing to participate in activities is prohibited and will be considered disciplinary.
- Respect the teacher's property! Do not tamper with or destroy any equipment or materials.

Students participating in Credit Recovery have addition information to complete.
