The student(s) must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and complete a scholarship application, as well as an interview with the scholarship committee. Applicants must reside in Western Jefferson County/Bessemer Cut-off area. Applications are available from the high school counselor, or the Bessemer Voters League.

#### SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Scholarships will be awarded based solely on academic excellence.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

An applicant should:

- 1. Be high school senior residing in the Bessemer Cut-off of Jefferson County
- 2. Have at least a 2.5 grade point average on a four-point scale.
- 3. Show evidence of worthy character, promise and leadership qualities.

#### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

The applicant must complete and submit all of the following:

- 1. An official copy of his/her high school transcript including Fall 2017 semester grades.
- 2. A Essay on "WHY A VOTELESS PEOPLE IS A HOPELESS PEOPLE" (typed with 1" margins, Times New Roman(12) or Arial font (12), and not more than two pages).
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation must be from a high school counselor, teacher and/or administrator, religious/civic leader, employer, or volunteer supervisor, who will vouch for the character of the applicant. THE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION CANNOT BE FROM A FAMILY MEMBER.

#### **DEADLINE:**

Application packet must be submitted via U.S. Mail and postmarked no later than Friday, April 20, 2018 or via email to <a href="mailto:tbyrd3@bellsouth.net">tbyrd3@bellsouth.net</a> by 11:59 PM on Friday, April 20, 2018.

#### **SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS:**

After the interview process recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee on or before **May 13**, **2018**. Selection will be based on the applicant's written application, essay, academic excellence, and interview.

The Scholarship Committee will review applications. Eligible applicants are required to attend an interview. If you are selected, the distribution of the scholarship award will be contingent upon receiving proof of enrollment at a higher learning institution.
