

School Uniforms

Students attending **Jackson Intermediate School** are required to adhere to the following uniform dress code each day:

- Khaki pants or shorts – **No cargo, Capri, cut-offs, leggings or baggies. Cargo pants** defeat the purpose of uniforms because they have large pockets that can hold unnecessary things. Shorts should be the proper length, no shorter than a hand-width (about 3-4 inches above the knee) and loose fitting.
- Khaki jumpers
- Khaki skirts or skorts. Should be the same length as shorts or longer.
- Brown or black belts – must be worn if clothing has belt loops.
- Shoes – Any color tennis shoe. **No Sperry shoes or shoes with wheels built in the bottom. No open toes or heels.** Lettering must be small, no larger than 1 ½ inches.
- White tights
- Polo style shirts – Colors should be hunter green or white. Only solid white T-shirts may be worn under polo.
- Sweatshirts or Sweat jackets must be hunter green or white with polo worn underneath. Hunter green jackets may also be worn inside.
- **Heavy jackets or coats must be taken off inside the building. PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME INSIDE ALL JACKETS AND SWEATERS THAT MAY BE TAKEN OFF DURING THE DAY.**
- Book bags should be regular shoulder strap or back pack. **Rolling book bags will NOT be allowed.**

Consequences for not following dress code are as follows:

- 1st and 2nd violations - Parent will be called to bring proper dress.
- 3rd violation – Parent and student will have a conference with the principal.
- In-school suspension will be considered for repeat violations. Beyond that, a student will be referred to the Clarke County Board of Education.
