**Pre-registration Instructions for 2020-2021**

Parents, Guardians, and Students,

As we prepare for the 2020-2021 school year in our current state of unknown due to the Covid-19 pandemic we are working hard to get ready for next year. We are going to utilize an online pre-registration through google forms to allow your students to choose classes for next year. Please click on the link for the grade that your student will be in next year and select the classes from the drop down menu. We will be offering a few new classes next year that we are excited for your students to have the opportunity to take. We are implementing the 2019 Alabama Math Course of study. All 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will take geometry and be our first group to graduate under the new course of study. The State of Alabama is also pushing out a new Computer Science initiative that will begin next year. We will be offering the Exploring Computer Science course for grades 9 through 12. This will lead to other computer science courses in the following years. Finally, we are excited to partner with ESCC to offer their Medical Assistant Technology program for our 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. This will require using two of your students' elective spots in their schedule. We will discuss options for summer school to make room for the MAT program if they are in two of the following electives: Band, JROTC, and Weight Training. For our 10<sup>th</sup> grade students, this program will offer them the opportunity to graduate with an Associate's Degree if they complete the 3-year program having only paid for 3 classes through ESCC. Please take your time in selecting the courses and know that honors level courses will also require teacher approval. This will be done once all forms are collected. We will contact you if you have signed up for the honors classes. Please complete the forms by Monday, May 18, 2020. If we do not receive your form you will receive classes based on our judgement. Class changes will not be made after the first week of next school year. We look forward to hearing from you and preparing to come out of this pandemic prepared for the new school year.
