Summary Reports for October 2015

Kindergarten

The students will be using sight word pop games and sight word apps.

First Grade

The students will be working on math skills, such as subtraction strategies, missing addends, comparing numbers and fact families.

Second Grade

The students will learn math skills by using flip books to unwrap math standards and using Mountain Math to learn place value skills.

Third Grade

The students will learn multiple step word problems by practicing and using open ended problem strategies.

Fourth Grade

The students will learn tips and rules from the book "Essential 55". The teachers will implement Rules 15 (awards) and Rule 18 (organization) as they would fit in their classrooms.

Fifth Grade

The students will learn tips and rules from the book "Essential 55" by surprising others with random acts of kindness at least once a month. The students can write a thank you note or a note of an apology.

Sixth Grade

The students will continue to learn to build character by using Habit #3 (Put First Things First). The teachers will continue to praise the students and display good habits in the hallway.

Other PLC Groups

Special Education

The special education teachers discussed materials to use in the resource center for general education teachers.

Physical Education

The students are learning good sportsmanship behavior before and after competitive play. The students are role modeling good sportsmanship.
