<b>Elite</b>	ACT composite score 30 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 1340 or above	16 in-state tuition hours per semester, Housing, & Meal Plan; renewable for up to 4 years
<b>Faculty</b>	ACT composite score 26 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 1190 or above	16 in-state tuition hours per semester; renewable for up to 4 years
<b>Gamecock</b>	ACT composite score 24 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 1110 or above	9 in-state tuition hours per semester; renewable for up to 2 years
<b>Gem of the Hills</b>	ACT composite score 22 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 1030 or above	6 in-state tuition hours per semester; renewable for up to 2 years
<b>Leadership</b> (competitive, supplemental documents required)	ACT composite score 20 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 950 or above	12 in-state tuition hours per semester; renewable for up to 2 years
<b>Valedictorian</b> (supplemental documents required)	ACT composite score 22 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 1030 or above	16 in-state tuition hours per semester; renewable for up to 2 years

## FRESHMAN OUT-OF-STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Non-Alabama residents, excluding residents of one of the ten approved Georgia counties. Students qualifying for an out-of-state scholarship will be eligible for the in-state tuition rate; 2015 high school graduate.

Leadership (competitive, supplemental documents required)	ACT composite score 20 or above or SAT Critical Reading & Math score 950 or above	12 in-state tuition hours per semester; renewable for up to 2 years
