- Daily Schedule:** 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (includes breaks)
7:55 a.m. – Warning Bell
- Dress & Behavior:** Students must abide by the Geneva County School Board *Code of Student Conduct*.
- Textbooks:** Furnished by school. Students must provide paper, pencils, etc.
