LATE ARRIVAL DAY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 11 due to PSAT TESTING

Only students paid and registered for PSAT will be testing the morning of October 11th.

Students not testing are scheduled for late arrival, at 12 pm, beginning with 4th period, on Wednesday, October 11, due to the PSAT administration.

- BUSES WILL BE RUNNING AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED TIMES.
- Students not taking the test and who report to HHS in the morning will be placed into study hall from 8 am until 12 pm.
- PSAT registrants will need to report to their assigned testing room by 8 am on 10/11 to begin the test.

ATTENTION PSAT PARTICIPANTS, Wednesday, October 11th

- Test begins promptly at 8 am.
- Bring 2--#2 pencils, and calculator. MECHANICAL PENCILS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
- Know your testing room location, and report to that room on testing day. They are displayed in the school front entrance.
- No late arrivals will be allowed in the testing room. If a student is late, they forfeit their right to test.
- October 11th is a scheduled late arrival day for non testing students, beginning at 12 pm with 4th period. After the test concludes, testers will head to 4th period.

SCHOOL INFORMATION

STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Student Drop Off and Pick Up is <u>located in the front of the school</u>. No other locations are allowed on campus or in nearby neighborhoods. Students being dropped off/picked up in ocations that are not permissible will be assigned discipline.

Attendance Reminders:

<u>Check In/Out Policy:</u> Students must be checked in/out at the main campus, not at Hoover Hall. There are two ways to check out a student:

 Arrange the check out ahead of time. (This can be done earlier, the same day or weeks/months in advance and MUST be done in at the school by a person on their contact list.)
Walk up to check out at the bell change. (Students may meet you at the check-out desk, but cannot wait for you if you are not physically in the lobby.)

*Students MAY NOT be checked out with a note, email, fax or phone call.

Students MAY check themselves IN with a parent note or a doctor note. Otherwise they have to have a parent's signature. Any check in without a note or parent signature is automatically unexcused.

CHROMEBOOKS

Repairs- If your device is currently in need of repair, please take it to your school to turn in for repair. Students can plan to receive their device back within the first few days of school. You can submit a repair request via<u>www.hcseli.com</u> by selecting the service requests tab at the top right hand corner and clicking on repair request.

Note- If your student turned in a device for repair at the end of 2016-2017, those will be sent to the school as well for distribution. If they are attending a different school than they were at last year, the device will be sent to their new school.

New students- All students grades 3-12 who have completed on line registration, agreed to a device, and do not owe fees for technology will automatically be sent a device. No request needed. The school will distribute the devices on their schedule.

Charger Request- If your student needs a new charger, please fill out a request form via our website <u>www.hcseli.com</u> by selecting the service requests tab at the top right hand corner and clicking charger request. There is a \$40 charge for all chargers and it is not included in the protection plan.

Protection Plan- If you have not purchased the Protection Plan for the 2017-2018 school year, you can do that via<u>www.myschoolfees.com</u> and select the IT Department as your child's school. Here are more detailed instructions if you need them. <u>https://goo.gl/qfmiJY</u> Please remember that the Protection Plan is an annual purchase that runs from the first day of school in the year paid to the first day of school in the next year. You will be purchasing the 2017-2018 school year.
