ACT ASPIRE SCORES

ACT Aspire results were sent home today, Friday, August 18th, for current 9th and 11th graders who tested with HCS schools this past April. A supplemental handout was also provided which aids in score interpretation. The ACT Aspire readiness levels are reported as Ready, Close, or In Need Of Support.

READY category -- students have met the ACT Readiness Benchmark and are on target for 50% or higher likelihood of college course success by grade 11.

CLOSE category -- students scored below, but near the Readiness Benchmark
IN NEED OF SUPPORT category -- students performed substantially below the ACT readiness
benchmark

PSAT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The PSAT/NMSQT is scheduled for Wednesday, October 11, 2017. The deadline to register is Friday, August 25th. The fee for the test is 16.00. This optional test will be administered at HHS, beginning at 8 AM on 10/11 and will last approximately three hours. Taken as an 11th grader, this is the qualifying test for National Merit Scholars Recognition.

Interested 10th and 11th graders may register for this test by following the two steps below

- 2. Pay 16.00 fee via secure4.myschoolfees.com or cash/check at the bookkeeper. No refunds will be issued.

Instructions for paying tuition online:

 - a. Default password is student's 8-digit birthday in the format J@MMDDYYYY.
- 2. Select Student Tab, then click on Access Your Online Services
- 3. Select the Student Tab, then select Student Account
- 4. Select Account Summary, scroll to bottom of page and click Credit Card Payment
- 5. Select Term, then Submit
- 6. Enter Payment Amount, then Submit
- 7. Enter all information on this page and click Continue. Follow instructions to finish payment process
- 8. Print receipt for your records.

Attendance Reminders:

<u>Check In/Out Policy:</u> Students must be checked in/out at the main campus, not at Hoover Hall. There are two ways to check out a student:

- 1. Arrange the check out ahead of time. (This can be done earlier, the same day or weeks/months in advance and MUST be done in at the school by a person on their contact list.)
- 2. Walk up to check out at the bell change. (Students may meet you at the check-out desk, but cannot wait for you if you are not physically in the lobby.)
- *Students MAY NOT be checked out with a note, email, fax or phone call.

Students MAY check themselves IN with a parent note or a doctor note. Otherwise they have to have a parent's signature. Any check in without a note or parent signature is automatically unexcused.

CHROMEBOOKS

Repairs- If your device is currently in need of repair, please take it to your school to turn in for repair. Students can plan to receive their device back within the first few days of school. You can submit a repair request viawww.hcseli.com by selecting the service requests tab at the top right hand corner and clicking on repair request.

Note- If your student turned in a device for repair at the end of 2016-2017, those will be sent to the school as well for distribution. If they are attending a different school than they were at last year, the device will be sent to their new school.

New students- All students grades 3-12 who have completed on line registration, agreed to a device, and do not owe fees for technology will automatically be sent a device. No request needed. The school will distribute the devices on their schedule.

Charger Request- If your student needs a new charger, please fill out a request form via our website <u>www.hcseli.com</u> by selecting the service requests tab at the top right hand corner and clicking charger request. There is a \$40 charge for all chargers and it is not included in the protection plan.

Protection Plan- If you have not purchased the Protection Plan for the 2017-2018 school year, you can do that via www.myschoolfees.com and select the IT Department as your child's school. Here are more detailed instructions if you need them. https://goo.gl/qfmiJY Please remember that the Protection Plan is an annual purchase that runs from the first day of school in the year paid to the first day of school in the next year. You will be purchasing the 2017-2018 school year.
