Summer School Registration Reminders

Registration Opens on Tuesday, May 2.

Online payment for Drivers Ed WILL NOT be available.

-You can only register & make your payment at the school. Remember there are only limited spots available for Drivers Ed, so plan to register early.

Online payment will be available on myschoolfees.com for all courses except Drivers Ed

-Online payments can be by electronic check or using Mastercard or Discover (3% transaction fee applies to all credit card transactions). After making payment online, student are required to turn in their registration packet to the school.

On Site Registration at the school will begin at 7:45 am

-ONLY cash and checks (payable to Hoover High School) are accepted at the school. Students/Parents should be prepared with completed and signed registration packets (including counselors signature) and payment for on site registration.
