After making payment online, student are required to turn in their registration packet to the school.

-ONLY cash and checks (payable to Hoover High School) are accepted at the school. Students/Parents should be prepared with completed and signed registration packets (including counselors signature) and payment for on site registration.

Meets: Monday thru Friday from 8:00 am – 1:00 pm at Hoover High School

Cost: \$200.00 per semester class

Notes: Health will meet the first day of each term and all other assignments are submitted virtually (All assignments must be completed by the last day.)

Driver's Ed will meet the first 5 days of the term and students will drive two other days during the term.
