Check In/Out Policy: Students must be checked in and/or out at the main campus, not at Hoover Hall.

Check-out Policy

Students may be checked out ahead of time (the morning of, a week before or even a month before) by a person on their contact list. *This process works best for all.* Once the check-out slip is filled out we will hold it until the morning of the check-out, when we call them down and give it to them. They will show the slip to their teacher and are able to exit class at the time on the slip with no disruption to class.

Students may not check out with a note. **Someone on the checkout list** must physically come in to sign them out. Students may be called down to be checked out between periods or during the first or last 5 minutes of class only. Calling into the classroom during instruction time is very disruptive. Walk-ins are accepted during these times only. Keep in mind that the process may take a few minutes so please allow plenty of time. Thank you for your help with this matter.

Check-in Policy

Students may check themselves in with a parent note or a doctor note. If they DO NOT have a note a parent must sign them in. Any student checking in without a note or a parent signature is automatically UNEXCUSED.

The ASVAB is scheduled for Thursday, April 6, 2017 at Hoover High School for interested 11th and 12th graders. It will begin at 8:00 AM in A 109 and last approximately 3 hours. The deadline to register is Tuesday, April 4th. All students interested in participating in the ASVAB Career Exploration Program must register at <http://bit.ly/2m2uBNa>. This test is offered to interested 11th and 12th graders at no cost. This test will provides information about verbal, math, science and technical skills. ASVAB scores can be used to enlist in the Military after graduation but student are under no obligation as a result of taking the ASVAB.
