Check In/Check Out Policy During Exam Days

Parents should not check out students during exam days.

Students in all classes are expected to be present and in their assigned places during the scheduled exam period.

Students are not allowed to take exams early without prior approval from an administrator.

Make-up exams must be pre-arranged with the teacher.

Parents please include all adults on your child's emergency contact list that are able to check out your student in the event they are sick at school. Students who drive need an adult to come to the school and sign out the student if they need to leave the school due to illness.

Summer School Registration Reminders

Summer School Driver's Ed classes are full. There will be no more registration forms accepted for Driver's Ed summer school classes.

-You can only register & make your payment at the school. Online payment will be available on myschoolfees.com for all courses. -Online payments can be by electronic check or using Mastercard or Discover (3% transaction fee applies to all credit card transactions). After making payment online, student are required to turn in their registration packet to the school.

-ONLY cash and checks (payable to Hoover High School) are accepted at the school. Students/Parents should be prepared with completed and signed registration packets (including counselors signature) and payment for on site registration.

Notes: Health will meet the first day of each term and all other assignments are submitted virtually (All assignments must be completed by the last day.)

Driver's Ed will meet the first 5 days of the term and students will drive two other days during the term.
