CO-OP INFORMATIONAL MEETING for 2017-18 will be held on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, during all advisory sections (5A-D) in Room C133. Rising Juniors and Seniors who are pre-registered for cooperative education will receive a meeting notice in their 1st period teacher's box. Students who did not request Co-op but wish to consider as a schedule

option are encouraged to attend the meeting. At the meeting each attendee will hear about program expectations and receive a co-op packet with an application, a student information sheet and three (3) teacher recommendation forms. All documents distributed at the meeting are due back by May 20<sup>th</sup> in order for the student to be cleared for program participation. Students who do not submit a completed and signed application by 5/20/17 will be removed from the program and have a schedule change.
