LAW ACADEMY 4: MOCK TRIAL/MOOT COURT TEAM

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Course Goals and Content:

This final level course of Law Academy is designed for students with an interest in fields related to law. Students will engage in mock trial, moot court and youth legislative processes. This course is designed to incorporate the three previous Law Academy courses into an interactive law process. Throughout this course students are expected to play a role in actual court proceedings. The course will culminate with a competition

Course Supplies: iPad, copy of the Federal Rules of Evidence (available online for free), and a positive attitude!

Points and Assignments: Total points will be used to determine a student's average. A variety of assignments will be given, including papers, projects, and performances. As this class is designed to be the mock trial/moot court team, **participation will also be a major portion of students' averages.**

Late work: If a student misses one of the major panel discussions, they will be required to write a short essay on the covered topic to make up for the discussion credit. Unless a student has otherwise made arrangements, I use the following guidelines for all late work / make up work.

1. All assignments are due on the due date and can receive full credit.
2. An assignment that is one day late can receive $\frac{3}{4}$ credit.
3. Assignments received up to five days late can receive $\frac{1}{2}$ credit.
4. After one week, assignments will be recorded as a zero.

General Information: Class expectations for conduct will be the same as those found in the SPHS Student Handbook. Academic honesty is critical within Law Academy. If any student is found plagiarizing or cheating in anyway, that student will receive a 0 on the assignment and full disciplinary action will be taken. In addition, working on other class work during Law Academy will not be tolerated. If a student is found using a cell phone or other electronic devices (iPad, etc.) without permission, it will be confiscated and given to school administrators for pick up.
