Their Eyes Were Watching God - Essay Prompt and Rubric

Name

Prompt: Analyze Hurston's use of one <u>motif</u> in *Their Eyes Were Watching God* and how it illustrates one of the novel's <u>themes</u>.

Thesis Statement: Develop your thesis statement by, first, deciding which motif you would like to focus on. What does that motif represent? What is Hurston's claim, or message, regarding the subject you would like to focus on? A thesis statement might be structured like this:

Prove Your Argument: Use your motif chart to come up with 2-4 examples that prove your thesis to be true. Support your argument with *relevant* quotes from the text.

Requirements: Write a 4-6 paragraph analytical essay (introduction, body, conclusion). Use at least two quotes to support your argument. Follow proper MLA formatting and parenthetical documentation. Do not forget the Works Cited page. (*Note: the publication date is the most recent date listed on the title page.)
