- E. Discuss Slim's role in the novel. In what ways is he proven to be a God-like character?
- F. Explain the <u>cyclical nature of Steinbeck's writing</u>. Cite several examples of cyclical patterns in characters/events/motifs.
- G. Discuss the <u>role of Curley's wife</u> in the novel. Does Steinbeck successfully <u>invoke sympathy</u> for this character?
- H. Determine whether <u>Lennie</u> is a fully innocent character or one who is capable of discernment and manipulation. Should he be held accountable for his actions?
