ART I SYLLABUS

- 1. Notebook: Vocabulary: ART IN FOCUS Textbook (daily vocabulary of 5 terms), questions assigned from chapters, CRITIQUES (Summary of the Elements of ART)
- 2. Still-life studies: Drawing concepts introducing VALUE (shading techniques). Students will be drawing a minimum of 5-8 studies.
- 3. Basic 3 dimenstional exercises to develop drawing skill in 3-D.
- 4. 1 & 2 Point perspective introduction: block letters, floating shapes, Interior spaces
- 5. Colorwheel: color-mixing, painting, monochromatic, complementary, analogous
- 6. Positive & Negative Space concepts: Counterchange project
- 7. Grid method: copying from a photo and enlarging/reducing/reproduction.
- 8. Drawing in reverse: White Pencil on Black paper and scratchboard (coated inked paper)
- 9. Pen & ink: Drawing with a guill (line, textures, value)
- 10. Watercolor: introduction of washes and transparent/translucent techniques
- 11. Printmaking: Inks, brayer, Styrofoam
- 12. Clay Sculpture: Handbuilding techniques, pinch pot, coil & slab methods. Glazing, firing and acrylic finishes.
- 13. Portraiture: learning how to draw faces, frontal, ¾ to left & right, foreshortening
