Parent Involvement Plan

The school will offer opportunities for the parents to take an active role in the student's education by offering a forum for collaboration with staff members, activities that will aid in the education of the student beyond school hours, and provide timely information about Title 1 programs.

The following are the primary features of a plan that will incorporate strategies for parental involvement that will contribute to shared responsibilities for high student academic achievement.

Strategies that will be utilized to promote this plan:

1) A parent involvement meeting will take place at the beginning of the year to inform parents regarding the school's involvement in Title 1. At this time the school will distribute and/or review:

- \* The School-Parent Student Compact
- \* Title 1 funding budget information/spending items
- \* Opportunities to communicate with the teachers and administration to improve the academic performance of their child.

2) Numerous opportunities will be provided throughout the school year to strengthen the building ties between parent and school. These will include:

- \* Parent volunteers will serve on Title I/ Leadership committee throughout the year to advise on all Title 1 parent involvement matters.
- \* Suggestions from the teacher for activities/materials for parents to involve their students at home in their educational development.
- \* A Parent Resource Room has been established to allow parents to check out Reading and Math materials to take home to work with their children

- \* Students with perfect attendance will be recognized and given an award of some type at the end of each nine weeks during the school year and have their picture put on the school website.
- \* Parents may meet with the teacher thirty minutes prior to school, during the teacher's planning time, or thirty minutes after the end of the school day. Teachers will need a one day notice for meetings.
- \* Parents are invited to attend their child's classroom each year for day/night class learning/activities to include: Reading, Science, Art, PE, and Music as scheduled at various dates throughout the year.
- \* The school will provide a summer reading intervention program to allow students time to enhance achievement in reading based on identified areas using the following assessments: DIBELS, Scantron Performance Series, and formal classwork.
- \* The school will provide a K camp for all new registered K students to prepare the students for Kindergarten.

3) As a school wide Title 1 school, a survey will be distributed at the end of the year to all parents. The feedback from this interment will allow the school to evaluate the Title 1 program; furthermore, the school will make changes to improve the Title 1 services based on the responses.

This plan will be updated on an annual basis to reflect the dynamic needs of the parents and school.
