



A Note from Your School Nurse

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Welcome to Cedar Hill Elementary !

I am here to take care of your children by promoting health, and preventing illnesses in the school. If your child has a medical condition that I need to be aware of, please contact me.

Listed below are Limestone County Schools Policies regarding illnesses

Notification- Parents will be contacted for head injuries, temperatures and suspected communicable diseases. Parents are not routinely notified for minor injuries or visits to the nurse. You will be asked to pick up your child if he/she has a temperature , vomiting , diarrhea, unexplained rash, or constant cough and or runny nose.

******* STUDENTS MUST BE FREE FROM TEMPERATURE, VOMITING OR DIARRHEA FOR 24 HOURS (WITHOUT MEDICATION) BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL *******

Medication- If your child requires medication at school the physician must complete a Prescriber/Parent Authorization form. These forms must be signed by the parent as well as the Physician in order for medicine to be administered. You can obtain the PPA (Prescriber/Parent Authorization form from me or from the Limestone County School handbook. Parents must bring the medication to the school along with the completed form. Students are not permitted to carry medication unless authorized by their physician.

Paperwork must be submitted each school year regarding medical needs.
