


Academic Achievement - 40.00% Overall Score

1. Academic Achievement- 40% This was measured using the ACT Aspire scores in reading and math.
2. Academic Growth- 50% This was measured using ACT Aspire scores across years.
3. Chronic Absenteeism- 10% The state identifies a student with 15 or more absences, excused or unexcused as a chronic absentee.
