

Madison City Seal of Academic Distinction for Graduation Cohorts 2014-2017

In addition to earning the Advanced Academic Endorsement, a student may gain the Madison City Seal of Academic Distinction by earning Advanced Placement credits as outlined below based upon graduation year:

- ☆ Graduation Cohort 2014 (the Rising Senior Class): One AP Course Credit
- ☆ Graduation Cohort 2015 (the Rising Junior Class): Two AP Course Credits
- ☆ Graduation Cohort 2016 (the Rising Sophomore Class): Three AP Course Credits
- ☆ Graduation Cohort 2017 and beyond (the Rising Freshman Class): Three AP Course Credits

In course selection, we also encourage you to consider the following:

- ☆ Student's academic strength shown on EXPLORE or PSAT standardized tests
- ☆ Student's interest and enjoyment of the material
- ☆ Student's individual activities and other time commitments
- ☆ Student's maturity and work ethic
- ☆ Student's post-secondary plans
