BOB JONES HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL GUIDELINES

Schedule

The school day will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 2:35 p.m. each weekday from June 1st - 28th and an extra session for Driver's Ed. and Health from June 29th through July 13th. Students may enter the building at 7:50 a.m. and must leave campus by 2:45 p.m. The day will consist of four 85 minute instruction sessions, two 10-minute breaks, and a 30-minute lunch.

Attendance

The State Dept. of Education requires 120 clock hours of instruction for each Carnegie unit of credit. It is essential that students attend and be on time each school day. A maximum of two excused absences (one for ½ credit courses) will be allowed. Absences will be excused for illness with a doctor's note, death of a close family member, or legal reason. Parents and students are encouraged to check with the administration regarding the nature of an absence before it occurs. Any unexcused or more than two excused absences (one for ½ credit courses) will result in the student being withdrawn from school with no credit or refund. Four tardies (two for ½ credit courses) to class will equal an unexcused absence and withdrawal with no credit or refund. Any lost instructional time (tardies, check-in/outs, and/or absences) must be made up at a cost of \$5.00 per hour. Make-up days will be on Saturday School. Students will be held no less than one hour for each tardy and/or check-in/out. **Failure to make-up and/or pay for lost time will result in the student being withdrawn without credit or refund.**

Check-In/Out

Students arriving late or leaving early must check-in/out through the office and be accompanied by a parent. Any student who misses more than 210 minutes of instruction due to a check-in/out will be counted absent for that day.

Conduct

No discipline problems will be tolerated. Any referral to the office will be subject to immediate dismissal without credit or refund. Minor infractions may result in the student being assigned to Saturday School at a cost of \$5.00 per hour. Failure to attend and/or pay for Saturday School will result in immediate dismissal without credit or refund.

Lunch

Lunch will NOT be provided. Please make sure you send your student with their own brown bag lunch. Students will not be allowed to leave campus to get lunch, and parents are asked not to deliver lunch. No ordering from restaurants will be allowed.

Fees

All fees must be paid at the time of registration. Additional fees will be added for students who need to attend Saturday School. No fees will be refunded unless there is an insufficient number of students (i.e., less than 20) and teachers available to have a particular course.

Damage to School Property

Any damage to school property by a student must be paid before grades are released. This includes lost or damaged textbooks and laboratory equipment.
