Please note that blocks and terms are used only for sample purposes in the above chart. Courses cannot be chosen for specific blocks and/or terms. Science and Social Studies are scheduled in opposing semesters but could be in either semester. This enables students to only have three core courses per day (barring extenuating circumstances). Each student has twenty terms, thirteen of which are filled with required courses. Students may choose from 9 week, semester, or yearlong electives to fill their remaining seven terms. Students should choose several alternates, making sure there are enough to match their elective choices term lengths.
