

6th Grade Trip SPACE CAMP Spring 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Liberty Middle School sixth grade students will have an opportunity to attend Space Camp this spring. While at Space Camp, your child will be housed in the on-site habitat facilities with 24-hour security and nursing staff. This is a week-long, overnight trip. The cost is \$500 per student, which covers tuition, all materials, and meals each day. You will be responsible for transportation and any medicine drop off/pick up. You will drop off your child at Space Camp on **Sunday, April 21st**. Parents may attend an orientation meeting that evening. Graduation ceremonies will take place the **following Friday, April 26th**.

Liberty has reserved the week of April 21st through April 26th. *Please make sure* that there is not a conflict with this week and other activities before you sign up and make payment. It is highly discouraged for your child to “check out” of Space Camp during the week. If your child leaves, it is the decision of the Space & Rocket Center Staff whether or not he/she will be allowed to return and finish camp. **No refunds.** Field trip paperwork and Space Camp online registration must be completed for your child to attend. After payment is made, you will receive a link for online registration.

You may pay between now and Dec. 6th, 2018.
