

Car Pool Pick-Up Instructions for Parents

1. Starting Thursday, August 22nd, it is important that you have a school-issued yellow tag when picking up your child in the car pool line. This is for the safety of all students.
2. Your school-issued yellow tag must be displayed on passenger side visor. It can be secured by a rubber band or a clip of some sort. If you do not have a yellow tag, please let your teacher know and one will be made for you ASAP.
3. If possible, please choose the same lane each day so your child will be able to locate your car faster. Please discuss this with your child so they will become familiar with it. Due to the change in car pool procedures, you can turn any direction you choose when leaving the parking lot.
4. Teachers will be calling students one row at a time as cars pull forward and around the curve.
5. Please instruct your child to LOOK for your car and LISTEN for their name.
6. Once your child's name has been called, they should stand up and wait to be told when to load by the teacher on duty.
7. When your child is told to load, please remind them that it is imperative to enter the car quickly and close all doors. If your child does not come soon after the students start loading, please raise your hand through your driver's side window so that the teachers on duty will be aware. Please do not exit your car in order to retrieve your child. A teacher will insure your child comes to your car.
8. For the safety of the students and teachers on duty, please make sure your car comes to a complete stop and stays at rest once the students start loading.
