miDevice Guidelines

(A complete list of guidelines will be available at the parent meeting)

- The Mobile County Public Schools Acceptable Use Policy will guide the use of personal devices
- The teacher is the instructional leader and determines when and how personal devices are to be used and stored while at school
- Personal devices should arrive to school functional and fully charged. These devices should also be labeled with the student’s name
- Students are responsible for the safety, operation, troubleshooting and repair of their own devices
- Personal devices will not be shared

Approved Devices

- ✓ All devices must have a 7 inch screen or larger
- ✓ iPad Mini, iPad: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or future Generations.
- ✓ Android devices with Android Version 2.2 or newer (Kindle, Nook, etc.)

Devices Not Allowed

- × iPods or iPod Touch
- × Laptops
- × Nintendo DS, PSP, etc.
- × Pandigital Novel

- Return signed miDevice Parent/Student User Agreement
- Use personal devices for educational purposes only
- Follow Copyright Laws and Internet Acceptable Use and Safety Policies
- All necessary apps will be loaded by student or parent at home

Parent Responsibilities

- Return signed miDevice Parent/Student Usage Agreement
- Understand the security and filtering provided by MCPSS
- Support copyright law and Internet Safety
- Troubleshoot and maintenance of their student’s device
- Complete surveys provided by school
