Show students the AutoBGood episode on Responsibility. Ask: What were some of the responsibilities that Cali had while Franklin was away? What was her plan to make things easy for herself? What was the result of not having a plan for watering the flowers? How do you think she felt about responsibilities? How do you think Franklin felt when he saw what had happened to his flowers and shed? How can Cali fix the problem she caused? Pass out the interactive notebook cover, character page, and responsibility page.
