



WHY INTERVENTION?

Behavior Intervention Specialists are here for those students that may need help in certain areas (academics, behavior, attendance) and would benefit from individual attention and services that focus on their individual needs. These students need that extra "push" in the right direction in an effort to avoid continuing problems and encourage positive productivity. We work with the student as well as family, school staff, and community organizations to ensure all issues are being addressed.

TARGET STUDENT(S)

5th, 8th, and 9th Grade student(s)* identified on a tier system by Principals and Counselors based on their current needs.

Tier I Student meets academic and behavioral goals

Tier II Student intermittently meets academic and/or behavioral goals

Tier III Student that often has difficulties academic and /or behavioral goals

Tier IV Student that is in danger of not meeting academic and/or behavioral goals with Chronic C, D and E infractions, legal system involvement (arrest, probation, truancy).

*We will provide preventive services for tier II and III student(s) and may provide referral services for student(s) that don't currently meet program criteria

CRITERIA FOR REFERRAL

Potential at-risk students who present with academic, behavioral and social barriers to learning with a history of "A," "B" or their initial "C" offenses

REFERRAL PROCESS

Principal/Counselor(s) will assess identified student for appropriate referrals. Students with immediate needs will be assessed and referred to other agencies as needed.
