Course Syllabus: 2016-2017

Introduction/ Course Description: The main goal for my students is for them to be college and be career ready. With that said, we will be learning 7th grade Common Core Standards. The classes will be an hour long, so we will have plenty of time to review and learn new concepts. The course will have a lot of hands on activities along with group work. We will have homework at least 2-3 times a week. If a student misses a day, they **MUST** get the work that they missed. The missed work will show up as a “1” in the gradebook.

Grading Procedures: Students will receive assignments and will be graded based on completion and participation during this course. Any major projects or assignments that may count as a test grade, students will be notified in advance and will be completed in the classroom. Students are required to complete ALL of their work in a timely manner.
