# What is Early College?

- A way to earn college credits through the University of Alabama.
- Students take the Gateway class in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade, then UA courses in grades 11 and 12.
- These courses transfer to almost any college or university.
- At this time, the only cost is for textbooks.



# How are UAEC classes different from AP or Dual Enrollment classes at Murphy?

- UAEC classes are taught by University of Alabama professors.
- Most courses are taught online, but some blended courses will be offered, with the professor visiting every three to four weeks for lectures.
- Students will be both students at Murphy High School and the University of Alabama.

- UAEC applications will be available in the Main Office during December – February. Follow the instructions, complete the application, and attach a copy of your ACT results. Bring to my office in the University Building or place in my box.
