What does it mean to be a Title 1 school? Being a Title 1 school means we receive federal funding (Title 1 dollars) to supplement the school's existing programs.

What is the 1% set-aside? Mobile County is required by law to set aside 1% of its Title 1 allocation for parental involvement. For NMCK-8 School, that means we have \$2,063 for parenting.

What is the LEA Title 1 Plan? This plan addresses how the LEA will use Title 1 funds throughout the school system. For NMCK-8 School, current programs funded by Title 1 funds is Title 1 Facilitator/Math Intervention Teacher, Professional Development, Technology/Computers, and Copy Machines.

What is the ASSIST Continuous Improvement Plan (ACIP)? The ACIP is our school's Continuous Improvement Plan and includes the following:

- A Needs Assessment and Summary of Data
- Goals and Strategies to address Academic Needs of Students
- Professional Development Needs
- Coordination of Resources/Comprehensive Budget
- The School's Parental Involvement Plan

What is the School-Parent Compact? The compact is a commitment from the school, the parent, and the student to share in the responsibility for improved academic achievement.
