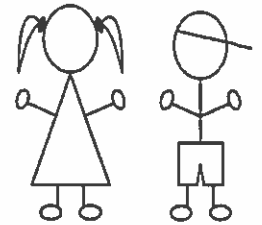
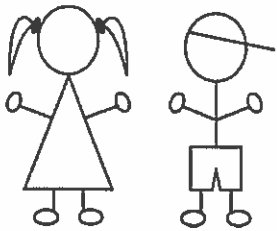


Pearl Haskew Elementary



School wide Leadership Roles and Descriptions

School wide leadership roles are an opportunity for all students to participate and take responsibility for our school environment. Students will be responsible for staying or going where they are instructed to. Students must always be courteous, and use good manners. Students who do not follow these instructions will receive a written warning, after two warnings a student who still makes wrong choices will be terminated from their position.

Job descriptions and responsibilities:

Haskew Ambassador for PTO Meeting—Responsible for meeting and greeting guest, giving directions or showing guests where they need to go. Must have a firm handshake and be able to make eye contact.

Haskew Ambassador for new students—Responsible for meeting and greeting new students. Responsible for showing new students around school and introducing them to the 7 Habits. Must have the ability to make friends easily.

Haskew Ambassador for Grandparent's Day—Responsible for meeting and greeting guest. Responsible for showing guests where classrooms and the cafeteria are located. Must have good manners.

Haskew Ambassador for school visits—Responsible for meeting and greeting guests. Will be responsible for showing and telling guests how we are a Leader in Me School. Must have good speaking skills.

Haskew Ambassador for Honors Assemblies—Responsible for meeting and greeting guests. Responsible for showing or leading guests to the gym. Must show strong leadership skills.

Haskew Ambassador for Thanksgiving Day Lunch—Responsible for meeting and greeting guests. Responsible for showing guest to and from the cafeteria. Must have the ability to wait for lunch.

Library Leader—Responsible for checking in or out books. Responsible for putting books where they belong. Must be able to do the right thing when no one is looking.

Knightly Rider—Responsible for picking up school wide bulletins, print shop orders, and other informational items from the office and taking them to each classroom. Must have good directional skills.

Recycling Hero—Responsible for collecting and sending all items recycled to their proper place or classroom. Must have a love to recycle.

Litter Leader—Responsible for picking up trash and “mystery paper” in and outside of the school building. Must have a strong feeling for a clean environment.

Master Gardner—Responsible for planting and pulling weeds in the Outdoor Classroom and around the school building. Must love to work with dirt.

PE Posse—Responsible for maintaining and placing PE equipment. May be responsible for leading other students. Must be able to follow directions.

Tech Expert—Responsible for turning on computers in the computer lab daily and setting up for classes. Must have strong tech skills.

Mascot—Responsible for wearing a Pearl Haskew costume. Responsible for entertaining students and guests. Must have school spirit.

Treasurer—Responsible for taking the money envelope to and from classrooms and the office. Must be trustworthy.

Patriotic Leader—Responsible for putting up and taking down the flag daily. Responsible for taking down the flag before it rains. Must have a strong sense for patriotic duty and reverence for the flag.

AR Mentor—Responsible for reading to and with other students on different grade levels. May assist students signing into AR. Must have a love of reading.

Bus Buddie—Responsible for picking up kindergarteners, and some first graders, from their classrooms and taking them to the afternoon bus dismissal classroom. Must have good people skills.

Lunch Buddy—Responsible for helping kindergartners and some first graders with their lunch treys. Must love to work with younger students.

Haskew Journalist—Responsible for interviewing students and adults. Responsible for recording and writing about school events. Must have a love of journalism.

Haskew Photographer—Responsible for taking pictures of all events. Responsible for organization and display of pictures. Must have a photographers eye.
