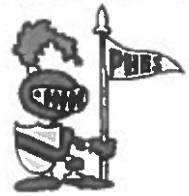

Mission Statement

The mission of Pearl Haskew Elementary School is to develop and motivate learners who respect themselves and their community.

School-Wide Discipline Goal

Pearl Haskew Elementary School's school-wide discipline plan is based on the belief that all students are unique individuals who are valued and treated with dignity and respect. Our goal is to promote appropriate social behaviors in all settings. The plan is designed not to punish students for inappropriate behaviors but to change negative behaviors to positive behaviors through self-reflection and self-discipline. We feel that this plan is necessary and conducive to a positive school atmosphere in which effective learning takes place.

Listed below are school-wide rules, positive incentives, consequences, and A, B, and C offenses with the disciplinary action to follow.

Positive Incentives

(These incentives are in no specific order of occurrence)

- Teachers are required to make monthly phone contact with each parent with documentation of call on the telephone log provided.
- A student may be referred to the Principal for positive behavior and/or good work. If this occurs, the student may receive verbal praise, a special certificate or note, and/or a phone call will be made to parents relaying the good news.
- An Honors Program will be implemented in grades 3-5 every nine weeks.
- Perfect attendance will be acknowledged daily by the classroom teacher. A star will be placed on a classroom shield (outside of the class) each day the class has 100% perfect attendance. The class per grade level with the most stars at the end of the quarter will be able to eat their lunch outside at the picnic tables.
- Random acts of kindness will be announced over the announcements.
- Shields will be given out to all students for positive behavior or work by all faculty and staff. Once 50 shields have been earned on the class compliment chain, then that class will receive the Fun Box for 30 minutes.
