Community

Spanning 599 square miles, the Morgan county School District serves the educational needs of Morgan County, Alabama. Located in one of the region's fastest growing areas, the district enjoys a diversified economic base. Currently, the district consists of five high schools, three middle schools, four K-5 schools, and six K-8 schools.

The Priceville community is the fastest growing area in Morgan County. Most property within Priceville town limits is zoned as residential property. Typically, large tracts of land in this area are subdivided for new home construction. Most of the new subdivisions being developed offer houses targeted at first time buyers or young families. This has led to a steady increase in enrollment at the local elementary school and will eventually lead to an increase in enrollment at our middle school and eventually at Priceville High School.

School

Priceville High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling 460 students in grades 9 through 12. The high school re-opened in the fall of 2001 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2005. Priceville High School is accredited by **the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools**. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 93.3% White, 2.2% Black, 2.2% Hispanic/Latino, 0.8% Native American, and 1.5% Asian.

Curriculum

The **academic program** is organized on a modified block schedule of one (1) seven period day and four (4) block days. Seven (7) credits per year is the typical course load.

The **Area Vocational & College Programs (AVCP)** enables juniors and/or seniors to enroll in freshmen courses and earn college credits at local institutions of higher education.
