Mrs. Bolton - Syllabus - Visual Art - Level 3

Purpose

In High School Art 3 students will expand on what they learned in Art 2 as well as utilize the methods of art that show depth and distance. They will study many aspects of the arts, analyzing the master's works and using these concepts in their own work. Students will also continue developing their work by practicing with a sketchbook journal working on different concepts throughout the year.

Materials

Fee of \$25 and one 5.5"x8.5" sketchbook (this sketchbook will be used throughout the school year and will count 30% of grade) Students will also need to have a pencil to use everyday.

Daily Expectations

I expect my students to follow a simple set of rules:

Students are expected to participate fully in all classroom activities. No student is expected to be an accomplished artist upon entry into the class. The expectation is that the student will develop skills, through practice, during the year. Students will use class time for art class work only and always be prepared. It is the students responsibility to communicate with me if absent. Electronics are to be used only if directed.

Grading (major projects 60%, minor projects 30%, daily 10%)

Each students daily work and projects is graded on an individual basis with the following criteria in mind:

Effort - this means always striving for your personal best
Craftsmanship - you have used your time wisely and have done a careful job
Creativity/Originality - you have developed your own idea and not copied others art
Following Instruction - you have met the criteria outlined for each assignment
