


College and Career Ready Standards

Employment/Skill Credentials are offered through Career Technical Programs. Students can obtain First Aide, CPR and Certified Nursing Assistant certification through Health Science, Hunter Safety, Junior Master Gardener and NCCER through Agriculture and Natural Resources, MOS through Business Management & Administration and Information Technology, OSHA 10 and NCCER certifications through Welding Manufacturing/Construction and Industrial Maintenance, Barbicide through Cosmetology and ServeSafe Certification through Family Consumer Science.

Pickens County Board of Education and local Community Colleges: Bevill State CC, and Shelton State CC **articulate college credit** to students that complete sequenced course work with an 80 average in Career and Technical Programs: Business Management and Administration, Cosmetology, and Welding. Course work completed in grades 10 –12 is eligible for articulated credit.

Dual Enrollment and Early enrollment are available to students that have a desire to enroll in Career Technical Programs at the Community College level. Institutions offer scholarships for some Career Technical Program enrollment. Information on Dual and Early enrollment is available through high school counselors and the local community colleges.
