


Monday, February 27 – *The Cat in the Hat* Dress in black, white, red, stripes.

OR a place you'd like to visit (real or imaginary).






Wednesday, March 1 – *Wacky Wednesday* Dress your wackiest: crazy socks, unbelievable hair, backwards clothes, etc.
