The minutes from the 01-19-16 meeting were read and approved.

Financial Reports from EOM June were distributed to all in attendance. Valerie Kyzar reported that the balance in the checking account on 7/28/16 was \$17,654.

New Business:

- 1) Deer Hunt – Jay Kyzar reminded everyone of the dates for the 3rd annual deer hunt. The hunt will be Jan 13-15, 2017. Jay plans to tweak just a couple of things, but mainly the hunt will work just like it has the past 2 years. Jay has already sent information to the hunters who attended last year & hopes to save on advertising this year. Jay will call a meeting with just Guides & Landowners in the coming weeks.
- 2) Stephanie Snyder brought a motion before the group to purchase 2 new video cameras. One camera would be for Boys sports to use and the other camera for Girls sports to use to film games. She asked for a budget of \$700 to purchase the video cameras. 2nd by Nicole Stewart – All approved.
- 3) Stephanie Snyder made motion to ask cheerleaders to sell programs at football games again this year and give them ½ of the profits made from their sales. In previous years we have sold the program for \$5 and given the cheerleaders \$2.50 for each program sold. All approved
- 4) Stephanie Snyder made motion to purchase HUDL online film software for any GHS athletic team that would like to use the software. Last year only football and boys basketball used the service. It will cost \$800 for football and \$400 for each additional sport. All approved.
- 5) Stephanie Snyder made a motion to reimburse Bart Snyder for meals that he bought for football players for lunch at McDonald's during a 7 on 7 playdate. Reimbursement is about \$45. All approved.

- 6) Stephanie Snyder made the motion to retro-approve the funding of 5 hotel rooms and 20 meals for a group of football players that attended a football camp at the University of Alabama at the beginning of July. Since we couldn't have a meeting in time for the full group to approve, President – Michael Redmon gave verbal approval and asked that it be brought before the group at the next meeting. All approved.
- 7) Bart Snyder reported that he would like to give Barbara Allison a free ad in the football program to promote her charity – The Real Deal. Mrs Allison lost her son in a car accident and now she pays for a child to attend the AL Nick Saban camp each year in his memory. She is looking for donations and Coach Snyder would like to help her promote her charity by giving an ad. All Approved.
- 8) Bart Snyder reported on needs of the football team: shoulder pads, set of numbers to paint the field and coaches hats/shirts. Motion made by Valerie Kyzar to give the football team \$1000 for the shoulder pads & field numbers and to buy the coaching shirts/hats. Greg Bryan 2nd. All approved.
- 9) Kristie Freeman made a motion that the group help the cheerleaders buy another uniform by giving them \$1000. They have the rest of the money they need and this will help them complete their order. 1st – Pebley Williams, 2nd – Greg Bryan and all approved.
- 10) Chris Wilkes reported that he will take the Clock Officials test again this year to get certified to help curb the cost of 1 official. He asked that the booster club reimburse him approximately \$20 for the cost of the test. 1st – Jay Kyzar, 2nd – Dan Freeman, all approved.
- 11) Jay Kyzar brought up the need for a membership drive to encourage more families to get involved in the booster club. Will try to host a Meet the Eagles to get more parents involved this fall.
- 12) A discussion was brought up about Goshen apparel for fans. Stephanie Snyder, Kristie Freeman, and Pebley Williams agreed to form a committee to look at options for getting more apparel for Goshen fans. They will report back to the group on different options.
- 13) Robby Kinsaul brought up the need for a few new bats for Jr high and Varsity baseball. He can get a deal right now to buy 3 bats and get one for free. Motion made to give him \$1000 budget to get bats – 1st – Dan Freeman, 2nd – Jack Williams – All Approved.
