HOW WILL GOSHEN HIGH SCHOOL ACHIEVE EACH GOAL?

- 1. Improve their ACT+Writing score
 - Students will practice ACT problems in bell work and test questions
 - Teachers will utilize Differentiated Instruction while implementing various strategic teaching strategies
 - Teachers will ensure vertical and horizontal alignment with the CCRS curriculum
 - All assessments will include problems concerning scientific investigation including pictorial data as per ACT exemplars
 - Students will use primary and secondary sources in order to support theories and ideas as specified within levels 3 and 4 of Depth of Knowledge

2. Increase ACT Aspire scores

- Teachers in classes will explain methods used to find answers using complete sentence
- Teachers will require students to answer open-ended questions on homework, quizzes, and tests to practice writing explanation
- Use ACT Aspire Periodic Assessments and STAR results, as well as Global Scholar and Accelerated Math to gauge student growth throughout the school year
- Teachers will conduct student intervention interviews with students who performed at "Close" or "In Need of Support" to monitor progress
- Students will make use of Scope Scholastic magazine periodically throughout the year
- ELA teachers will incorporate grammar lessons 2-3 days per week
- Teachers will collaborate vertically and horizontally
- Faculty will be provided materials and resources to ensure rigorous and consistent academic program to support student growth
- Special education teachers will collaborate the general education teachers in order to lessen the Academic Gap between the Special Education subgroup and the Regular Education subgroup
- 3. All GHS students will graduate prepared for the rigor of post-secondary education
 - All 8th graders will visit all of the Pike County Academies
 - Parents are informed about the different academies offered by the Pike County School System

4. Reduce the At-risk Population

- GHS will have a Problem Solving Team (PST) to identify students in danger of failing and interventions will be put in place
- GHS will implement a mentoring program that will provide every student 7-12 with an adult mentor that will serve in this capacity throughout the student's entire high school career
