8th grade Physical Science Syllabus

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Dear Students, Parents and Guardians,

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to 8th grade Physical science! This year, students will participate in the State of Alabama's AMSTI Physical science curriculum. This four part program will allow students to learn about all the different aspects of physical science covered in the Alabama Course of Study for 8th grade science. The four parts of the program are: 1. Experimenting with Forces and Motion, 2. Electricity, Waves, and Information Transfer, 3. Exploring the Properties of Matter, and 4. Experimenting with Mixtures, Compounds, and Elements. Students will be exposed to the scientific concepts and activities that will ensure success at the high school level and beyond. This class is designed for the student to enjoy and participate in, but it will be what you make of it. It is very exciting for me to see students learning through discovery each year.

Grading

Students will be graded daily on the material that has been covered in the current unit. These grades are obtained as a result of group and individual participation.

**Grades will consist of

- 1. Daily work (groups and individual)----20%
- 2. Lesson tests/quizzes-----35%
- 3. Lab activities/notebook checks-----40%
- 4. Participation-----5%

Classroom Procedures/Rules

Procedures
