- Members are expected to put forth the time and effort needed to raise their standards when it comes to technique and performance ability. Every day is a day to improve and become a better performer.

Failure to meet any of these commitments may result in temporary or permanent removal from performances or the program. No financial refunds will be given if students are removed from the program for failing to comply with these standards.

Financial Commitment

The following is a schedule of membership fees payments for the Saraland Spartan Sound Band. Fundraising

Fundraising will be ongoing throughout the marching and indoor seasons. Students are expected to participate in all fundraising and meet *minimum fundraising amounts* for each fundraiser.
