We are pleased that you will be joining us! Please feel free to contact us with any questions. This is the first time that sixth grade has gone to Camp Winnataska, so we appreciate your understanding and flexibility. Mrs. Wendt has discussed the trip with all students, so your son/daughter may have some answers.

The students will be participating in these five activities: Canoe, Scavenger Hunt, Ropes course, Team building, and GaGa Ball. Your responsibilities will be to help ensure that our students are safe, courteous, well-behaved, and listening - especially to safety rules! As good citizenship requires participation, so do the programs at the Camp. However, if there is an activity that a student physically cannot do, we have asked them to tell us.

- You are not allowed to administer anything to or onto students that are not your children, such as sunscreen or bug spray. They have been told to do this at home.
- You have to arrange your own transportation. We suggest that you meet us at camp since there are a large number of you attending. If you plan to follow the buses, please understand that the bus drivers' job is to drive the buses. They cannot be responsible for your cars. (Our bus drivers use Mapquest, not Google maps.)
- You will not be able to go to the classroom until after announcements (about 8:00) if you are helping with lunches. It's a bit challenging to depart right after announcements; the teachers have to take attendance and attend to field trip "day of" preparations.
- SCC requires students to ride the bus for school trips - both ways. You can check out your son/daughter upon our return to school.
- Some of us bring a little extra food and water in case students forget.
