

**WHO:** SMS 7th and 8th graders

**WHAT:** the ultimate field trip

**WHEN:** April 22-28, 2017

**WHERE:** Charlottesville, Gettysburg, Philadelphia, and New York City

**COST:**

The price of the trip is based on the number of occupants per bus. That number is determined by the number of participants and the number of buses required. The exact price is determined when we know exactly how many people are going. It will be no lower or higher than the prices listed below:

**Quad Room: \$940 to \$970 per person**

**Triple Room: \$1000 to \$1030 per person**

**Double Room: \$1050 to \$1080 per person**

**The price of the trip includes the following:**

\*13 meals

\*all lodging

\*deluxe motor coach transportation

\*all tour and admission fees which are part of the trip

**PAYMENT DEADLINES:**

There are three payment deadlines that must be observed. They are as follows:

**\*November 15:** \$100 per person to reserve your spot

**\*January 13:** 1/2 of your balance

**\*March 10:** remaining balance

**Every student on the trip must have an adult along who assumes responsibility for the student. If your parent is not going, it is up to your family to locate someone who is willing to be responsible for you and allow you to stay in his or her room. Though we will try to help, the school is not responsible for finding you a roommate and chaperone.**
