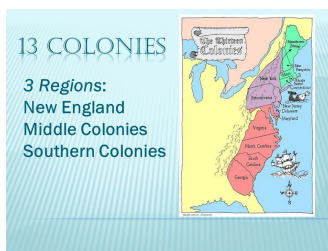

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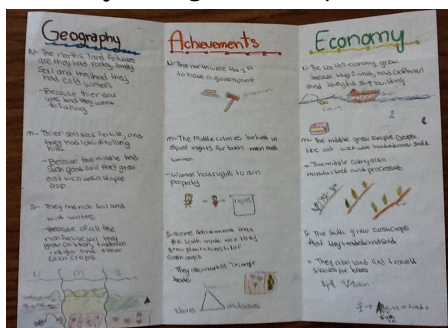
COLONIAL BROCHURE PROJECT



The English colonies were uniquely diverse in their economy, religious practices, government, and geographical locations. The colonies were classified into three areas; New England, Middle, and Southern colonies. For this project, you and your group will be assigned one of these colonial areas. You will use your notes and research to create a brochure for your assigned colony. To ensure you receive maximum points for this project, please follow ALL instructions in this handout and in the attached rubric.

Step 1: What is in your brochure?

- In your brochure, you must include the following information: colonies in the area, economy, religions, governments, and geographical features.
- Below is an example of how it should be set up. Yours will not look exactly like this. This is just a guide for you.



- On the front should be your title and pictures describing your colony.
- The second flap will have the colonies listed that are in the area.
- The inside of the foldable will contain the economy, religion, and governments of that area.
- The very back of the brochure when folded will have the geographical feature listed.

Step 2: Group Responsibilities
