Respect Yourself, Others, and Your Surroundings at all time: No bullying or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated in this classroom. The first incident, depending on the severity, will result in parental contact. Anytime after that will result in parental contact and discipline referral.

Be On Time: This means that all students should be seated and working on the bellringer. Any student who is not seated and working will be counted as tardy. When you come in the door, if you have any homework assignments you should turn them into your classes homework drawer. Any homework turned in after the tardy bell will be considered late. Bring Materials: Students should have all necessary materials with them such as pencils and paper. You must bring your composition notebook to class everyday. Consistent Failure to bring material will result in notifying parent/guardian.

Stay On Task: The entire time that you are in my class you will be learning. If we are discussing notes, I expect you to be focused and listening. If we are doing a class activity, I expect you to be participating and learning. If we are doing individual work, I expect you to be silent and work hard. Failure to do this will result first in a verbal correction and then will move to parental contact and/or discipline referral.
