Antarctica and Greenland make up the Ice Cap Zone of the High Latitudes.

The Great Plains of the United States has a steppe climate.

The zone with the most and different climate areas is the Mid-Latitude Climate Zone.

Sylacauga, Alabama is in the Mid-Latitude Zone with a Humid Subtropic Climate.
