She also served as a New Deal government official -- she was one of the 20 highest-level offices held by women in the administration, and the highest held by an African American woman. She played a key role in founding FDR's "black cabinet." She also served as president of the National Association of Colored Women, and she founded and served as president of the National Council of Negro Women.
