Admission requirements: High school transcript showing graduation date and type of diploma (must be an acceptable diploma); composite score of 20 on ACT or 950 on SAT (combined critical reading and math) for unconditional admission; composite score of 17–19 on ACT or 830–940 on SAT (combined critical reading and math) for conditional admission. GED is accepted in lieu of high school diploma.
