

Búsqueda española

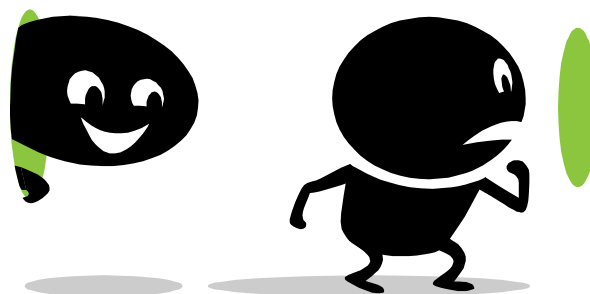
- You will be given 4 **weeks** to complete this scavenger hunt on your own. The final product will be due on the **3 of diciembre**.
- You will need to find all 22 items and collect them in a notebook or folder.
- You can find these items in newspapers, magazines, the grocery store, at community events, on the internet, etc.
- For the final product you need to make a scrapbook of all the items found, labeled neatly, according to their number on the checklist. All pages one-sided.
- You must include a short description and a sentence about where you found each item.
- You must turn in this sheet with the final product. It is ok if you write on this side.
- This project is worth **112 points**. See below for rubric.

| 1) | Picture and names of the current King and Queen of Spain |
| 2) | Names of 10 Spanish-speaking countries, their capitals, and their presidents (excluding Spain) |
| 3) | Coin/Bill from a Spanish-speaking country (may be a printout) – Tell which country it is from |
| 4) | News story about a Spanish-speaking country |
| 5) | Newspaper ad relating to a trip/tour in Spain or Latin America |
| 6) | Food label written in Spanish (the words salsa and tortilla do not count – these are loan words) |
| 7) | Names of 5 naturally cultivated food products from Latin America, their names in Spanish and the countries where they are found |
| 8) | Pictures and descriptions of 5 different food items or dishes from a Spanish-speaking country and the name of the country where they are eaten. |
| 9) | Recipe of a traditional Spanish or Latin American dish and your opinion of it (not included in your textbook). |
| 10) | Picture and name of a piece of traditional clothing from Spain or Latin America and what it is worn for.(not mentioned in your textbook) |
| 11) | Name of 2 popular songs played on the radio and their lyrics that have some or all words in Spanish.(Besides the ones used in the classroom) |
| 12) | Picture, location, and name of a 2 famous buildings or monuments in Latin America |
| 13) | Names of 5 famous Spanish-speaking people, where they are from and what they are famous for. |
| 14) | Names of 3 famous Spanish or Latin American artists, the name of a well-known work of art, and their country of origin. (Not mentioned in the textbook) |
| 15) | Names of 3 famous Hispanic-Americans and what they are famous for |
| 16) | Names of 3 Spanish or Latin American authors, the country they are from and the titles of famous works. |
| 17) | Name of an adult you know who speaks Spanish, how they learned the language and how you know him/her [Not a SHS teacher!] |
| 18) | 5 unique Spanish or Latin American holidays, a short explanation, and their dates |
| 19) | Instructions printed in Spanish |
| 20) | 10 animals with their names in Spanish |
| 21) | 5 places in the U.S. with Spanish names and the meanings of those names |
| 22) | 25 Spanish words commonly used in English (loan words) |
